

Section 39 (Liquor Licensing) Certificate

Liquor Licensing

A Liquor Licence from the Department of Racing, Gaming and Liquor is required to be obtained for the sale of liquor from a premises. Local government certification is required to be submitted with the application. Prior to submitting an application for a Liquor Licence, the applicant must seek Section 39 Certificate from the relevant local government.

A Section 39 Certificate is required for all new liquor licensing applications and applications for any alterations to existing licensed premises, including hotels, taverns, liquor stores, special facility licences, restaurants and cellar doors. Additional detailed information on how to apply for a liquor licence is available from the Department's website <u>www.rgl.wa.gov.au</u> (also refer menu Liquor, Liquor Licensing, click The Role of Local Government).

Section 39 Certificate (Local Health Approval)

A certificate issued by a local government under Section 39 of the *Liquor Control Act 1988* confirms that the premises or proposed premises complies with all the relevant requirements under the *Health (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1911*, under the *Food Act 2008*, under any written law relating to the sewerage or drainage of that premises under the *Local Government Act 1995* and the *Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1960*.

Local governments are able to condition Section 39 certificates if a premises has outstanding work to be completed, or withhold the certificate until the premises has been made to comply. Local governments may also impose conditions requiring that music not be amplified over a specified level.

Section 40 Certificate (Local Planning Approval)

Details of Application

To obtain a Section 39 Certificate the applicant must submit the following information to the Shire of Nannup:

- A detailed site plan demonstrating the location of premises to be licensed;
- A detailed internal layout plan of the premises, demonstrating the area of the premises to which the liquor licence will apply;
- Completed attached form.

A \$103.00 fee applies for Section 39 certificate requests.

Applicants should ensure that requests for Section 39 certificates are lodged promptly to ensure that the local government has sufficient time to process the application.

Section 40 Certificate (Local Planning Approval)

A certificate issued by a local government under Section 40 of the *Liquor Control Act 1988* confirms that the premises or proposed premises complies with the local government's Local Planning Scheme.

Local governments are able to condition Section 40 certificates, if the premises can only be made to comply with the planning laws, through the imposition of specified trading restrictions. Usually, any trading restrictions specified by a local government would be imposed by the Liquor Licensing Authority as conditions on any licence issued. For example, such restrictions could include noise levels or hours of operation.

Details of Application

To obtain a Section 40 Certificate the applicant must submit the following information to the Shire of Nannup:

- Detailed site plan demonstrating the location of premises to be licensed;
- Detailed internal layout of the premises, demonstrating the area of the premises to which the liquor licence will apply;
- Completed attached proforma describing type of liquor licence which is being sought, the nature of the proposed business, and trading hours.

An \$85.00 fee applies for Section 40 certificate requests as processing of the application involves land use information and property history searches.

Applicants should ensure that requests for Section 40 certificates are lodged promptly to ensure that the local government has sufficient time to process the application.
