"We loved the festival again this year. I just have one piece of feedback from one of my volunteering sessions. When I did 'Gate attendance' at the River Gate between 6-9pm on Saturday night, there were quite a few people trying to sneak through, some of which were abusive and another one went into a lenghty argument with me. My volunteering companion and I did not feel entirely comfortable and safe. When we went through the main gate to check out at the volunteer headquarters there were at least a handful of security staff there. While we had security coming past every now and again, I would suggest to have two security at the back gates as well in future events."



"The Goorbillyup stage is a bit annoying. It can be difficult to hear the act on stage in the amphitheatre over the sound from this stage if you are at the back of the amphitheatre. Also, i didnt go to any workshops this year as in past years it has been too difficult to hear presenters over this stage. Maybe something more low key/less amplified?????



"The festival was awesome but the glamping was disappointing. The glamping communication was terrible. Information was provided at the last minute and was inaccurate. They also breached my privacy by providing my contact information to all other Glampers without my consent. There were only 3 toilets for 100 people, no showers for clampers and a 60+ minute wait for the general camping showers. Dirty and nearly empty hand sanitiser. No top sheet. Our tent was broken into and things stolen- no security. I will definitely come to the festival again but won't Glamp, the insane cost was not worth it. "


Next year we hope to bring our grandson, aged three, to carry the Nannup Music to new generations.

"Outstanding line up, organisation and resulting atmosphere. I think our best ever festival, which as a festival attendee/performer for twenty plus years is saying something! Three observations.

The sound spill at Secret Garden from the food court, Tigerville and the Amphitheater this year was more significant than I've experienced before. It overwhelmed poor Jack Davies during his solo show at times, it was ridiculously loud. It's always been an issue but this year was more noticeable.

I appreciate that one aspect of the food court stage is to show case young people who are learning to perform. That said this year we routinely LEFT the area to eat because the volume was loud and the ability didn't come close to matching that volume. We've never done that before. Less is more on the volume front for this venue and line up I think. It also changed our eating choices at times. Eating lunch shouldn't be an endurance test!

I think NOT helping people deal with their garbage at the campgrounds was a mistake. The bins people COULD find were overflowing. If there was a skip bin this year for end of weekend rubbish disposal we couldn't find it. Most of the rubbish is gonna end up in your local landfill anyway so why stop providing a skip bin to make this simple for both campers AND you guys? And if you ARE going to do that make it clear before people arrive so we can plan better for it.

Say again magnificent festival. We will be back!

And so sad that Fairbridge had to pull the plug, that must have been a hard decision. We're glad you guys rode the post COVID storm successfully. Tough times, "

Disappointed that everyone of the 8 artistists I saw at Secret garden stage made a comment about the background noise from other stages. Maybe a temporary sound wall can be erected along the back to reduce this noise. There needs to be a better location for workshops as the 4 I attended had significant problems with participants hearing each other's comments due to noise from the 2 adjacent stages. One workshop leader took the group out of tent 123 to the far back corner to be behind Gorgilly stage and as far from Tiger stage so we could hear each other. I feel it is unfair on the presenters to have to work competing in a noisy environment ( noise pollution?)



This year and last year we couldn't get a shower given the lines were so long and waiting is near impossible with young kids for that long, nor should it be necessary. For our camping price, more portashowers feels justified. Thank you, love the festival "

"We really enjoyed the festival as always. The atmosphere was friendly and relaxing, love the food stalls and spending time at the brewery and bowling club. This year we didn't feel that there were any stand out performers and other people that we met at the festival had similar thoughts. There is an increase in heavy electric music and blues music on the main stage in the evenings. We appreciate the eclectic mix of music, however, we used to really enjoy the interstate and international artists that could offer something unique and surprising. "I have been involved in providing a wash station for Denmark markets/events. What we found that worked was to ask stall holders what crockery/cutlery they required and we took the plates/cutlery to the stalls and left them to use. Throughout the festival we had 'runners' who would top up the required plates. At the coffee vans we loaded a plastic crate full of cups and put this ontop of a milk crate and positioned this at the head of the coffee queues. We kept a record every year of what stall required what and this made it easier for the following year. Unless the plates are under everyones nose they don't get used. We also had the events plastic free-no water bottles were to be sold as there were refill stations and cupsvavailable. We also provide free second hand keep cups and you could do this with water bottles. We just put out a call and everyone donated or sourced them for us. We also had a black board and we would tally the number of plates, cups and utensils we used. A great visual reminder of what we saved from land fill."

"The kids area (where they do the tie dye) could be a bit bigger and those workshops should be accessible for the duration stated on the program (not be maxxed out in half an hour) but! the volunteers are awesome and we are still very appreciative! A few more activities for the 12ish age group would be good and I thought we'd see some sand sculpture being made."

The only negative was that the internet connection was insufficient for the vendors and there was nowhere to withdraw cash. I would have spent a lot more money if I had brought cash. I wish I had known how important it was to bring a good amount of cash with me. And also \$2 coins for the festival bus. It would also be great if there were more shower facilities and perhaps some temporary signage for the camping area. It was impossible to find friends, as there was no way to tell them where we were camped and quite treacherous for finding our camp walking back at night. Otherwise, it was just brilliant. I loved it and hope to return next year. Thank you!"

"Congratulations to all involved for another fabulous weekend. We have been regulars for many many years now and it is always a top weekend.

I attended 2 singing workshops on Saturday. Unfortunately both artists were struggling to compete with the sound coming from Tigerville, and found finding the right key a real struggle at times. As a participant I also found it incredibly distracting and it detracted from the experience. It would be great if a more suitable venue for singing workshops could be considered please.

We attended 2 performances at the Nannup Brewing Co. We also went to one in 2023 but didn't stay long as it was impossible to squeeze into the space in front of the band, and the sound in the undercover area when you first walk in seemed distorted. We decided to go again this year as there were 2 artists we really wanted to see, but again it was overcrowded in front of the band and the sound was not good. We found the best place to listen to performers at the Brewing Co was actually sitting on the lawn outside the toilets near the Town Hall!

I wonder if it is possible to consider setting up the stage right at the bottom of the terraced area, so more people can see and hear the acts?
