All correspondence will be sent to the address of the ratepayer for the property. The FCO or authorising officer has the right to grant, refuse, alter or add any conditions to an application or for complex variations, request a bushfire planning consultant completes the application. Where an application is not approved by the Shire, the owner has fourteen (14) days in which to comply with the normal requirements of the Shire's Fuel Hazard Reduction & Firebreak Notice ("The Notice"). Failure to comply with The Notice may result in a \$250 modified penalty being issue, in addition contractor's fees and administration cost may also be recovered.

I, the applicant consider it impractical to clear firebreaks, or to take measures in accordance with the Shire of Nannup's Shire's Fuel Hazard Reduction & Firebreak Notice requirements ("The Notice") issued pursuant to Section 33 of the Bush Fire Act 1954.
