



Nannup Recreation Centre Public Artwork Project.

Over the past two years Council has undertaken a renovation project to revitalise the Nannup Recreation Centre. A new function centre with commercial kitchen and community meeting room were constructed.

Council is now working to increase participation in recreation and cultural activities in the precinct. This activation project is a partnership of the Nannup Shire and the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries.

The aim is to incorporate a public artwork program into the project, this would be subject to funding approval.

Artists are invited to submit a concept design and quote for this site specific project. It must be noted that this artwork is not an entry statement to town.

Essential Criteria:

1. Concepts have been identified by community consultation and this will form the basis of the design.
2. This project is site specific, on the corner of Warren Rd & Centenary Ave (entrance to the Recreation Precinct).
3. Local timber is an integral component of the design.
4. Community participation, skills development workshops and engagement are to be incorporated into the construction element of the project.
5. All project costs to be incorporated into quote, including GST if applicable, structural engineering certification, insurance, materials, lighting (if applicable) and installation costs. This project is subject to funding applications and no variations will be incorporated at a later date.
6. The concept design must comply with Occupational Safety and Risk requirements. (No sharp corners etc)
7. A current CV with 2 referees and 2 recent projects included.

Timeframe:

Concept design and quote to be received to Council by 9am Tuesday 17th July.

Council will choose the design to be progressed.

Funding applications will be submitted in August and the project will commence when funding in full is received.
