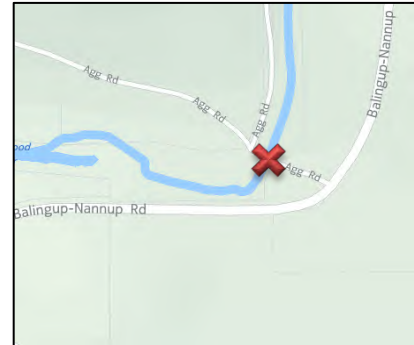
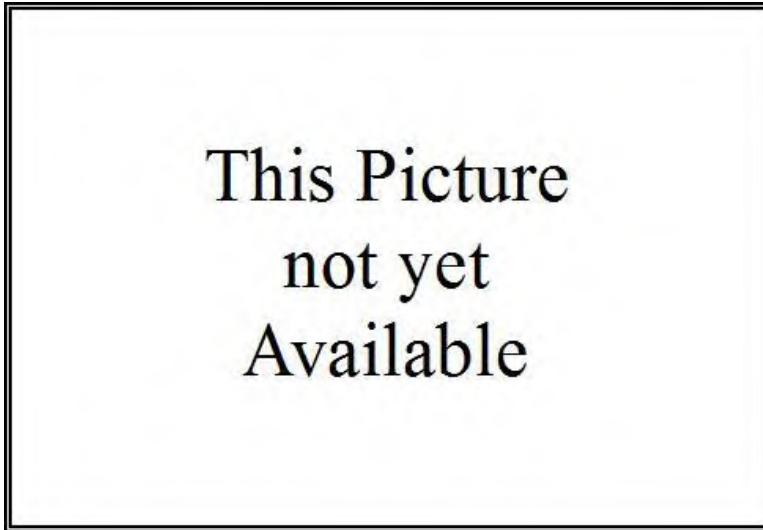

HISTORICAL NOTES

Reveley Bridge was constructed in 1921 to provide year round access to properties on the northern side of the Blackwood River. It replaced an earlier seasonal crossing located two miles further upstream.

DESCRIPTION

Reveley Bridge was originally constructed of locally milled jarrah with a wooden railing. The original bridge was demolished and replaced with a concrete structure in 2009.
